Mentoring Program

The Huntsville Bridge Center Education Committee is instituting a Mentoring Program to provide guidance for aspiring bridge players in all aspects of the game.

The first six month Mentoring Program will begin on January 2019.

Guidelines:

- All participants must be current ACBL members.
- The mentor/mentee partnership should be able to play two times per month for six months.
- The mentee must be considerate of the mentor's time and be willing to learn from the mentor.
- The mentor must be willing to share their time and knowledge in a considerate and unselfish manner.
- The mentor/mentee will want to spend a little time after each game discussing a few boards.
- The Education Committee will schedule a monthly Mentoring Game on Thursday evening.
- The program is open only to new partnerships.
- The mentee's Master Points cannot exceed 200.
- The Education Committee is responsible for partnerships. All participants may choose their own mentor/mentee with approval of the Education Committee. Both the mentee and mentor may provide input for the Committee about the type of partnership desired. The Education Committee will assign partnerships. Once you have been matched, you will receive a detailed letter about the program with the name of your mentor/mentee.
